

Title: Peace Camp Visual Arts Director Organization: Children's Peace Theatre

Peace Camp Description:

Every summer Children's Peace Theatre (CPT) hosts Peace Camp, a three-week day camp for 30 children aged 8-13, Youth guides (14-20) and a team of artists and Directors

Surrounded by lush forest at Children's Peace Theatre, Peace Camp involves the creation, rehearsal, and production of an original and stunning perfomance. The work is devised from the stories and imagination of the child campers based on a chosen theme that captures what's resonating for our communities. In the final week there are two public performances, including a popular and well-attended gala presentation.

Responsibilities:

June (4 meetings and panning time):

- Meet with Directors weekly to develop visual arts curriculum
- Develop curriculum and facilitate visual arts activities for art portions of camp (1 hour per day) to explore themes with campers using visual arts
- Work with Directors to integrate visual arts to guide campers to create arts installation for final performance
- Provide supply list for week one of camp at least one week before camp
- Provide bio and supporting materials for promotions

• Facilitate a session during Orientation to train team for visual arts

Camp Dates:

Monday to Friday **August 5-23**, from 9:00 am – 5:00 pm Gala Performance **Saturday August 24** 12pm-11pm

- Participate in 8:30 am opening circle every day during camp
- Participate in morning team meeting and share art requirements/plans for day
- Communicate daily with Directors
- Provide mentorship to Artist and Youth Guides in their roles to support campers during visual arts
- Direct artist guides, guides, and campers in art class building towards creation of work and final Installation(s).
- Provide supply list for production materials by Friday of Week One for Week Two creations.
- Attend closing circle daily to give art notes and support artists in ideation for scenes that could benefit from props/art work.
- Support front of house with Promotion of show-sharing materials and providing quotes etc.
- Provide direction to and communicate with Directors on art logistics for Gala
- Provide Directors visual arts notes for Program
- Participate in Q and A and at Gala
- Participate in closing circle after Gala
